

SERVICE PROJECT IDEAS

You and your mentor must decide on a service project you can do together during the year.

CHRISTMAS IN A SHOEBOX

You & your mentor could organize a drive for gathering materials for several shoeboxes. Get the congregation to help out! Contact Mrs. Bakke for printed material to use.

LEARNING CAFÉ

Help out once or twice a month on Monday afternoon.

LAIB & SEELE

Help out once a month on Friday night.

YARD CLEAN-UP AT THE CHURCH

Contact Bob Bakke or Dietrich Rein to find out what you can do. Try to do something on a regular basis.

ACB (select a couple of these to do)

Fold & stuff newsletters—monthly

Fold bulletins—weekly

Child care for someone in the church to attend Bible study or choir (no pay—weekly)

Serve on a church committee (once per month)

Lector (several times in the year)

Sing in one of the choirs

Chamber choir rehearses Tuesdays from 19:30 - 21:00

Contemporary choir rehearses after worship

Gospel choir rehearses Fridays beginning at 19:30

Plan, prepare, and serve Easter breakfast

Plan, set up, serve, and clean up coffee hour at least three times in the year (let church office know the dates)

Repair damaged hymnals

WORSHIP

Prepare a litany for use in worship

Share a musical talent in worship (at least twice)

Provide a **children's sermon** at least twice in the year

Prepare communion bread—I have the recipe. Communion preparation—bake bread, bring white wine and white grape juice. Set up before worship and wash the paten, chalices, and flagon after worship.

Sing in one of the choirs (see above)

VISIT A HOME FOR THE ELDERLY (approx. once per month)

Read/play games, etc.

WELCOME BAGS/PACKETS

Create welcome bags to hand out to new visitors. Include brochures, newsletters, Sunday school/Christian education material, treats for kids. Make handwritten notes welcoming new visitors. Check regularly to see how many more need to be made.

COLORING BAGS FOR KIDS

Check regularly that sufficient supplies are available. Make certain the bags have been returned to the hooks after worship. Help young children find the bags before worship begins.
